ARRIVING TO SEVILLE BY PLANE

[San Pablo airport](#) is about 10km. from Seville City Centre. It can be reached via main Spanish international airports (Madrid-Barajas, Barcelona, Mallorca and Malaga), which keep connections with main international airports in the world. [Bus line EA](#) travels from San Pablo airport to City Center (El Prado) which is the last stop.



ARRIVING TO SEVILLE FROM MADRID

- **By plane**

Non-stop regular flights between Madrid and Seville are offered by Iberia. There are usually 5 departures per day. The flight takes 1 hour. More info in: [Iberia](#).

- **By train**

Atocha Renfe high-speed train station can be reached from Madrid airport by either underground or taxi. If you choose [underground](#), you must change lines twice and the travel lasts about 54 minutes. The changes are the following

Start from Barajas International Airport in both T4 and T2: Line 8.
Change in “Nuevos Ministerios” Station: Line 6 or 10.
Change in “Tribunal” Station (Line 6) or “Pacífico” Station (Line 10):
Line 1.
Arrival at “Atocha Renfe” Station.

Alternatively, you can take underground line 8 from Barajas International Airport to “Nuevos Ministerios” Station, swap there underground for [“Cercanías” Renfe](#) (Spanish commuter rail system) and take any train to Atocha. The travel lasts 35 minutes from Barajas to Atocha.

The *high-speed train* AVE travels from Seville to Madrid 15 times a day. The travel takes 2 hours and 30 minutes. From Madrid: AVE leaves hourly between 7.00am and 22.00pm. From Seville: AVE leaves hourly between 6.45am and 21.45pm. Prices depend on the class and the time of day. More info here: [AVE Madrid-Sevilla](#).

In Seville, you can catch bus line EA in front of Central Train Station (Santa Justa) to City Center (Prado) which is the last stop.

● By train

From Barajas International Airport to Seville (Plaza de Armas), there exist two buses (at 21:15 and 23:15) and the journey takes a little less than seven hours.

Additionally, from Madrid South Bus Station (near to Méndez Álvaro underground/train station) to Seville (Plaza de Armas) there exist eleven buses covering the route according to the following schedule:

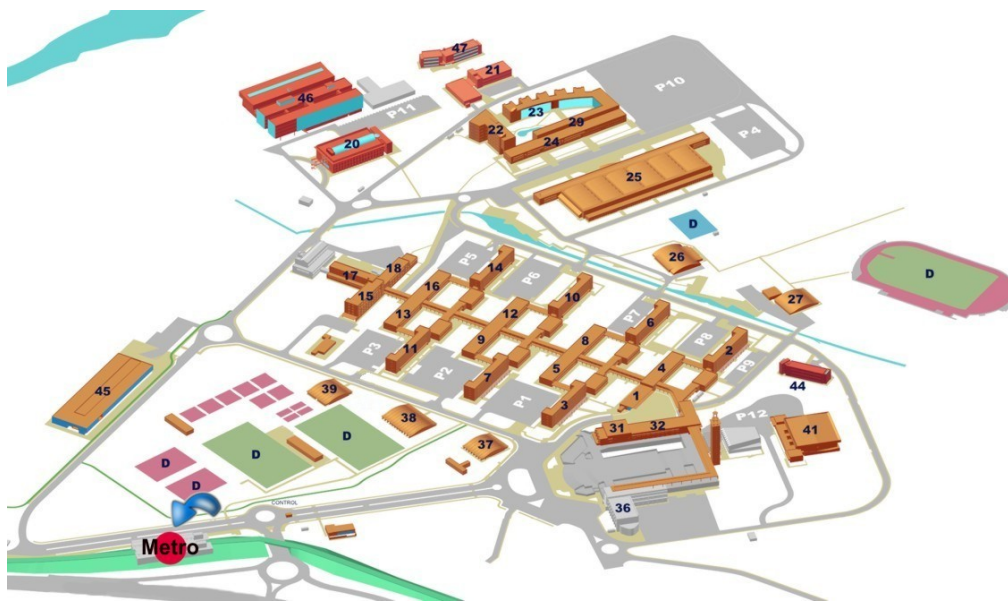

• By underground

You can catch line 1 of Metro Sevilla (Seville underground system) from [any station](#). The stations near the city center are “Puerta de Jerez” and “El Prado”. The campus station is “Pablo de Olavide”, being necessary to walk about 5 minutes on foot.

There are travels each 5 minutes at rush hour. More info: [Metro Sevilla](#).



• By bus

There exists a intercity bus connecting Seville and Pablo de Olavide University. Line M130 is operated by Casals and stops in “Avenida de Portugal” (the nearest stop from city center and next to “El Prado”). Buses pass at about each 20 minutes from 6:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. More info: [Line M130](#).
